Position Overview:

Youth Emerging Stronger (YES) is currently seeking a dynamic, entrepreneurial, and resourceful Director of Development and Communications who will lead all fundraising efforts for the organization and ensure that YES is maximizing the opportunity to leverage individual, foundation and corporate contributions. Reporting directly to and working closely with the Chief Executive Officer, the Director of Development will develop and execute a fundraising strategy designed to support the organization's future goals. This position is an exciting opportunity for an ambitious, strategic development professional.

Responsibilities:

- In collaboration with the CEO and Board of Directors, develop and implement ongoing comprehensive, strategic fundraising plan with specific, measurable goals that will enable YES to meet its current budget forecast and future goals; oversee implementation of plan
- Implement a fund development financial plan that outlines the long term financial needs and planned revenue sources of the organization; work closely with the VP/CFO in budget preparation. And monitor fund development metrics.
- Initiate, cultivate and steward relationships with the organization's major donors
- Identify, research and investigate new opportunities for funding from a wide variety of philanthropic, corporate and individual sources to expand donor base
- Oversee all proposals submitted to foundations, corporations, and other funding sources.
- Strategically leverage the time and connections of the Chief Executive Officer and other senior leaders to support aggressive fundraising targets, including developing the capacity of the Board to execute against development goals
- Plan, produce, and execute YES's signature Special events, individual donor-focused "house parties" annually, monthly major donor virtual briefings, quarterly member webinars, and more
- Research and cultivate special event donors and sponsorships for YES's annual Gala and donor related events
- Assist in the creation of event revenue budgets and contribute to the development of specific strategies and action steps to achieve revenue goal
- Represent YES in other public settings, advancing the organization's mission and visibility
- Develops communication plans to insure members, participants, and the community understand the case for support.
- Plan and direct the marketing and communication plan; Plan and oversee annual reports, newsletters, brochures and email campaigns.
- Provide guidance and leadership to the Development Department's team members and set high performance standards
- Others duties as assigned
